- Assist with initial and ongoing health assessments and the maintenance of patients' health
- Observe, measure and record patients' conditions - temperature, pulse, respiration, blood pressure and blood sugar levels
- Report changes in patients' conditions
- Attend to patients' hygiene & comfort by assisting with bathing, showering, dressing and bed-making
- Assist patients with meals when required
- Assist patients with rehabilitation exercises and programmes
- Assist in emergency situations
- Assist in educating on health & lifestyle issues
- Maintain a safe environment for patients and assist with the prevention of injuries
