This qualification addresses work primarily in residential facilities under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans.

These workers:

- Carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people in an aged care setting
- Carry out activities related to an individualised plan
- Report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers

### ASSESSMENT

Assessment strategies include:

- Observation
- Written tasks
- Integrated practical tasks

### FURTHER STUDY

When you finish this course you can enrol in the Certificate IV in Nursing (Enrolled/ Division 2 Nursing), the Certificate III in Allied Health Assistance or Certificate IV in Ageing Support.

Registered Nurse, Enrolled Nurse, Assistant In Nursing, Nursing Assistant, Nursing Support Worker, Patient Service Attendant, Patient Support Assistant, Patient Care Assistant.
